SUBJECT: Federal Occupational Health Unit Outreach Program

The US Public Health Service (USPHS), Federal Occupational Health (FOH) Unit will conduct a Health Outreach Program on Thursday, September 14, 2000, for CSS staff members located at 1707 Kalorama Road NW and 401 New York Avenue NE. The session will be held at 1707 Kalorama Road NW in Conference Room C from 9:00am to 12:00pm. The Health Outreach Program will present a 30 minute video titled *An Ounce of Prevention - Keeps the Germs Away*. This video was developed by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and will educate on preventive measures for the non-diffusing of infectious diseases. Also included on the agenda will be blood pressure screenings, a health education question and answer forum and literature distribution on various health topics including stress management, hypertension, cancer, cholesterol, and diabetes. The clinician conducting the session will be Mr. David Lee.
